



Information Points on how to apply.

1. Application is through the available online application form.
2. Read through the SpatialTrain Scholarships Scheme Regulations. Prospective applicants are advised to first go through these regulations and then move on to the application.
3. Applicants are advised to prepare beforehand the mandatory documents needed to be uploaded with the application. (Refer to Clause 10 of the SpatialTrain Scholarships Scheme Regulations for the list of supporting documents required.)
4. Please make sure that you receive an automatic acknowledgement after submission of application.
5. Applications' deadlines are as follows:

MQF Levels 4 and 5: **currently open indefinitely**

MQF Levels 6 and 7: **Call 2 - Friday, 6th September 2019**

6. Late and incomplete applications will not be accepted.
7. Applicants can only submit one application.
8. The Scholarship Grant is a tuition grant covering tuition fees (meaning enrolment, administration, workshops, registration and/or examination fees).

Grants for courses at MQF Levels 4 and 5 shall cover all tuition, including any assignments and examinations. Courses will be provided by *Epsilon Malta Limited – St Martin's Education Services Limited* and will be held at St Martin's Education Services Limited premises in Hamrun.

Grants for courses at MQF Levels 6 and 7 shall cover tuition fees held at the recognised accredited institute selected by the applicant. Tuition grants shall be paid against a tuition fee. The total tuition fee for all the course duration shall be that stated on the ULA. Payment for tuition fees will be effected as stipulated in Clause 15 of the SpatialTrain Scholarships Scheme Regulations.
